Shortlisted students are required to be present at the venue before

Each speaker is allotted 10 minutes. A bell will ring after 8 minutes as a reminder, and a second bell will ring at the 10-minute mark. This will be followed by a 5-minute Q&A session. After a bell prompt, the session will conclude.

Response and Answering Skills	25%
Oratory Skills	10%
Time Management	5%

- 3. The competition results will be announced on the same day, replacing scores with rankings, and the lowest-scoring participant will be selected.
- 4. The venue will be equipped with a projector and a computer. If assistance from staff is required on the day of the competition, please notify in advance.
- 5. Participants must personally attend the entire competition; otherwise, it will be considered as forfeited.
- 6. The entire competition will be recorded on the day, and the recording files will be securely managed by the Office of R&D. They will be destroyed within 30 days after the announcement of the winners.
